ActiveVOS Quick Start Guide

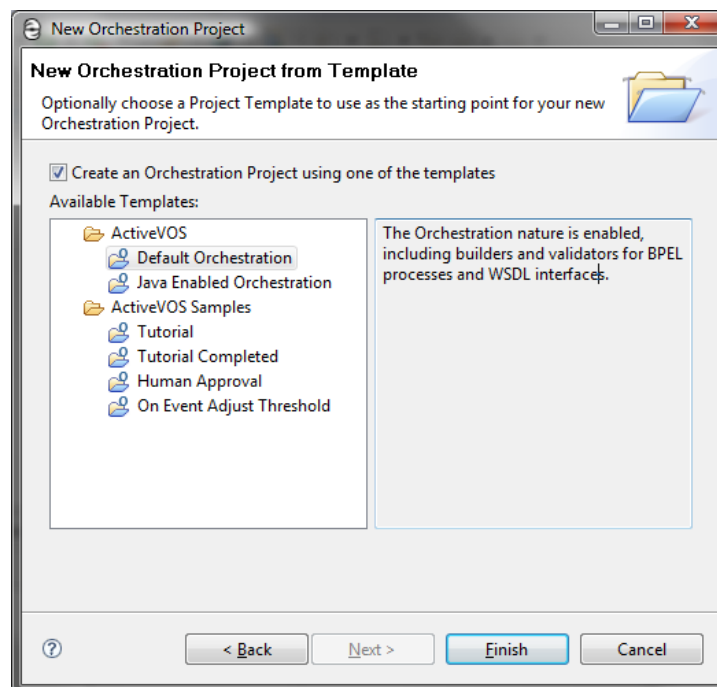
If you selected the default actions at the end of the installation of the ActiveVOS Designer this guide was displayed.

You do not need to install the ActiveVOS Server to learn about and evaluate ActiveVOS. Everything you need is provided within the ActiveVOS Designer installation that embeds the ActiveVOS Enterprise Server and a preconfigured Apache Derby database and Apache Tomcat server. You have everything you need to be productive. If you would like to install the ActiveVOS Server see a brief [ActiveVOS installation overview](#) below.

We recommend that you follow this checklist to guide you through the steps recommended to evaluate or learn about ActiveVOS.

1. Run the Product Tours to see the ActiveVOS in action. It's a great way to get introduced to ActiveVOS. You can access the Product Tour from the Microsoft Windows "ActiveVOS Designer" Start menu group or start it from the ActiveVOS Product Tour folder.
2. After launching ActiveVOS Designer, visit its Welcome page which will provide you with an ActiveVOS overview, a suggested list of first steps, explain how to get started with the Tutorial and our samples, and provide you with useful links to the Active Endpoint Education Center.
3. Review and take the time to learn how to get started with a set of simple "Hello World" recorded tutorials you will find at <http://www.activevos.com/community-educationcenter.php#Getting-Started>.
4. Take our comprehensive ActiveVOS Tutorial which covers building and deploying a service orchestration. The tutorial requires approximately 60 minutes to complete and provides you with in-depth knowledge on the use of the Designer and the creation and deployment of a service orchestration. To start the tutorial, launch the ActiveVOS Designer from the Microsoft Windows "ActiveVOS Designer" Start menu group and then navigate to Help> Help Contents> ActiveVOS Designer Online Help> ActiveVOS Tutorial.

5. After completing the ActiveVOS Tutorial, we recommend that you review the Human Approval process to learn how to incorporate human activity in a process. To do so create a “Human_Approval” orchestration project. Like all projects, an orchestration project is a container to store files, and it resides in the default location, the Workspace folder of your install folder. When you create a new orchestration project, it is also created in the same location in the file system.
 1. Select File>New>Orchestration Project, and click Next.
 2. Type in Human_Approval for a project name
 3. Click Next and select the “Human Approval” template, as shown.



4. Then, click **Finish**.

We’ve provided you with “Cheat Sheets” that will guide you through the project. Also included is a PDF document that provides in-depth background on the project.

Installing the ActiveVOS Server

Installing the ActiveVOS Server is optional for purpose of evaluation.
